

National Park Foundation Fact Sheet:

- The first designated national park started in 1872 with Yellowstone National Park.
- Woodrow Wilson created the official National Park Service in 1916 when he signed a law protecting the 35 national parks and future national parks.
- In 2016, the national park service contributed an estimated 34.9 billion to the United States economy.
